




The picture above shows a SilverSterling S2-IG Motor I/F port interfacing with a QCI-BO-MT. Transmotec DC motors with encoder option plug directly into the 6-pin connector. Power, communications and I/O are brought out through the DB15HD SIP port.

Do no connect the motor until the controller is initialized for the specific motor. A special file for your DC motor is required. Contact Support.


- 1. Open the Initialization Wizard under Tools
- 2. Click the Open button
- 3. Browse for the *Factory Default Init - Transmotec DC Motor.qcp* file included in this application note.
- 4. Enter the motor cable length
- 5. Click the Download File to Device button





6. Select Continue: No Motor Memory.

- 7. Select Motor Type and click Next.
- 8. Open Control Panel under the Tools menu to send test moves and jog the motor.
